Whereas: He has written over 100 instructional articles for the Autoharp Teachers Digest, the Autoharpoholic, the Autoharp Clearinghouse, and the Autoharp Quarterly, And,

Whereas: He is the author of four books of music for the autoharp, including Music from Missouri: Dance Tunes for the Autoharp and the autoharp section in American folklore: An Encyclopedia (1996, Garland Publishing), And,

Whereas: He has taught autoharp lessons for the Aniversity of Missouri's Communiversity program in Bansas City, Missouri, for over 30 years, And,

Whereas: He has taught, performed, and promoted the autoharp at festivals throughout the United States since the 1980s to include the California Summer Solstice, the California Autoharp Gathering, the Ozark Folk Center Autoharp Jamboree, the Willamette Valley Autoharp Gathering, the Mountain Laurel Autoharp Gathering, the Walnut Valley Festival, the Augusta Heritage Center Autoharp Week, and the Brasstown Autoharp Week, And,

Whereas: He has played his autoharp with contradance bands in the Bansas City area for decades, And,

Whereas: He is a two-time winner of the International Autoharp Championship and an eight-time finalist, And,

Whereas: He has made two recordings, Svite Liz and An Artistic Autoham, where he plays solo and with the American/Celtic group Calliope, And,

Whereas: It is included on the recordings Autoharp Legacy and Winfield Winners — Bolomes 1 and 2,

Therefore, let it be resolved that Tom Schroeder, be inducted with highest commendation as the 2017 contemporary member of The Autoharp Hall of Fame.
